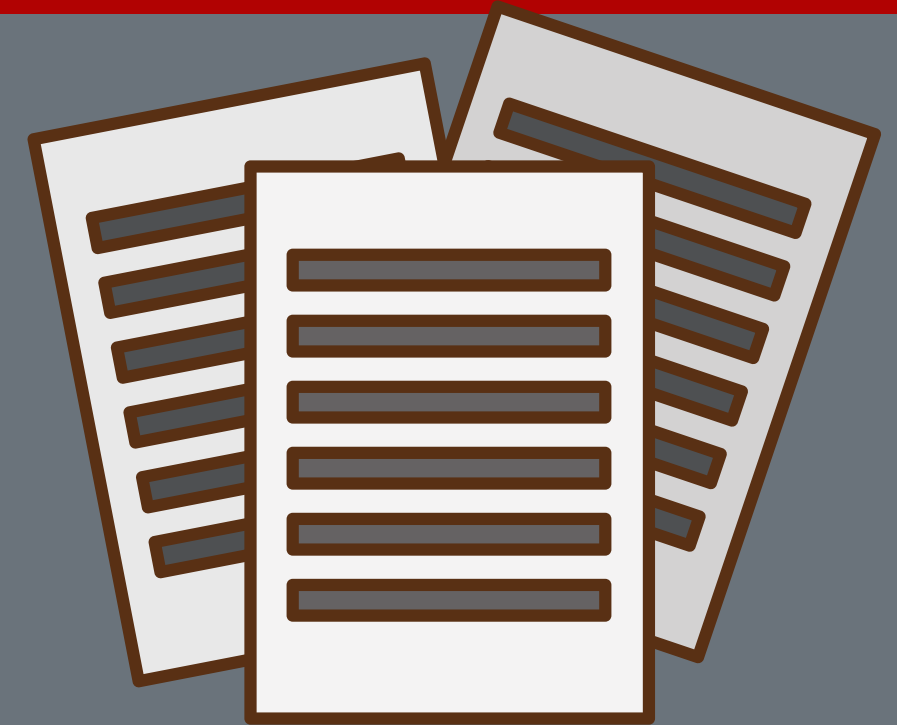


RESUME *or* CURRICULUM VITAE (CV)?

Resume comes from the French word for “summary.” Curriculum Vitae, often called a CV, means “course of life” in Latin. What’s the difference? Will you need both?

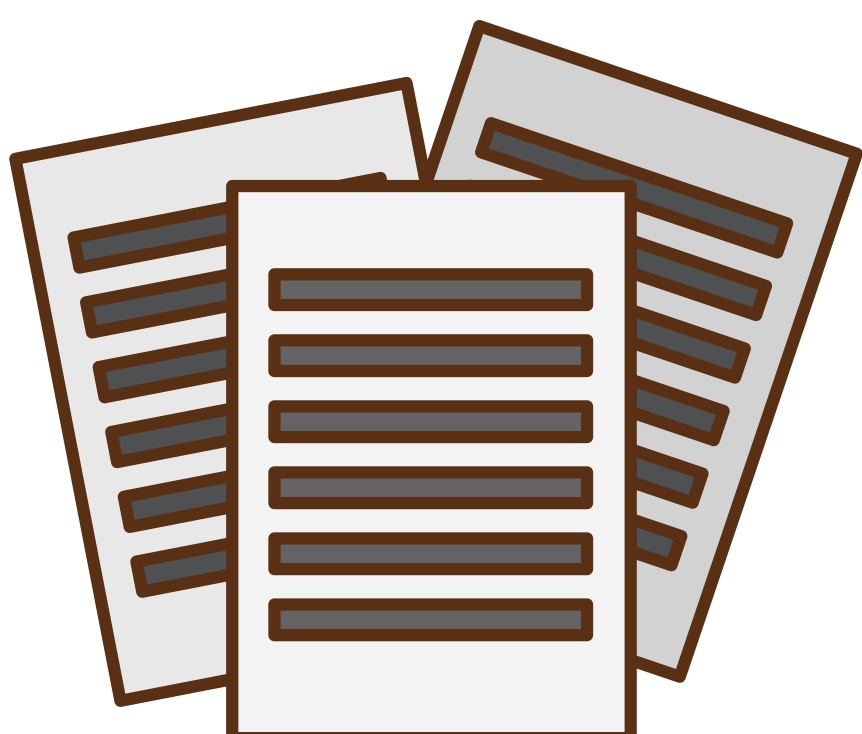


A resume presents a concise summary of your background, including job relevant information such as education and experience, formatted to fit on one page, two at maximum. A CV is more detailed, designed to provide a full history of your academic credentials, so it’s typically appropriate to be longer.

Both are tailored to the specific position, program or company/institution you are applying to. Both typically do not include a description of personal interests.

FORMAT & CONTENT

In general, you’ll need a resume to apply for a position at a business, not-for-profit and government entity; a CV is required for individuals seeking fellowships, grants, post-doctoral positions and teaching or research positions in post-secondary academic institutions. Graduate school applications typically request a CV, but in general are looking for a resume with detailed descriptions of research projects and publications.



Did you know?

In some European countries, the term “CV” is used to describe all job application documentation, including a resume. In the United States and Canada, the two terms are sometimes used interchangeably. When in doubt, ask for clarification.

A RESUME...

- Emphasizes skills, experience and education
- Is used when applying for a position in industry, non-profit, and public sector positions
- Should generally be one-page (Exception: individuals with 10+ years of industry experience and/or individuals with advanced degrees)
- Often features skills-focused experience sections, such as "Relevant Professional Experience" or "Community Outreach Experience"
- A resume is not static and is edited for each opportunity you apply for.

A CURRICULUM VITAE (CV)...

- Is a catalog of academic, professional and personal accomplishments
- Is used when a for graduate school, fellowships, grants, and/or positions in academia
- Includes these sections when appropriate: *publications, conferences, papers, exhibitions, presentations, honors and awards, relevant extracurriculars, volunteer and service, teaching, research, certifications and licensure, professional associations, language skills,*
- Always begins with education and research interest
